Re: Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your email dated the 3rd March 2021, requesting information in relation to deferrals or postponement in treatment of lung cancer patients.

The information that you require is as follows:

 How many patients were informed their Lung Cancer treatment would be deferred or cancelled within the period of March 2019 until August 2019. Can I also request the same data covering March 2020 to August 2020?

Note:

- The term 'cancelled' covers a wide range of scenarios and does not imply that a patient's treatment was delayed. For example, appointments will show as 'cancelled by hospital' if a patient's treatment plan changes, if they pass away or if their treatment location changes.
- The term 'deferred' refers to patients who attended their appointment but could not be treated e.g. because they were too unwell.
- Due to the nature of cancer treatment, individual patients often have multiple appointments per month. The figures in Q3 and Q4 cannot therefore be used as denominators for the figures in Q1 and Q2.
- The figures below are taken from treatment appointment outcomes.
