Thank you for your email dated the 12th May 2021, requesting information in relation to venesection.

The information that you require is as follows:

- a. For the most recent 12 month period available, the number of venesection procedures carried out by your organisation as a therapy or treatment for genetic haemochromatosis?
 As a tertiary specialist cancer treatment centre, our Trust does not carry out venesection procedures as a therapy or treatment for genetic haemochromatosis.
- b. For the most recent 12 month period available, the average total cost of a venesection appointment (to include clinical consumables, nursing or phlebotomy staff time, administrative overheads etc)

Our Trust does carry out this procedure for myeloproliferative disorders and for iron overload post cancer treatment. The average total cost of these appointments is £336.72.
