Re: Freedom of Information Request 372-2021

Thank you for your email dated the 10th December 2021, requesting information in relation to the treatment of Ovarian cancer

The information that you require is as follows:

- 1. How many patients have been treated for advanced (FIGO Stages III and IV) high-grade ovarian (epithelial ovarian, fallopian tube or primary peritoneal) cancer over the last 3 months?
 - 124 patients have been treated with SACT within the period

If none, do you refer ovarian cancer patients to another trust, if so which one?

- 2. How many ovarian cancer patients (any stage) have been treated in the last 3 months with:
- Paclitaxel in combination with a platinum-based compound = 37
- Platinum-based therapy alone (cisplatin or carboplatin) = 44
- Bevacizumab in combination with paclitaxel and carboplatin = 6
- Olaparib = 29
- Olaparib + Bevacizumab = 4
- Niraparib = 26
- Rucaparib = 25
- 3. Of the ovarian cancer patients (any stage) treated over the last 3 months, how many patients:
- Received HRD (homologous recombination deficiency) testing = HRD not recorded in system
- Received BRCA testing = 15/191 ovarian patients had the BRCA status recorded in the system. Test may well be requested, report received and signed by consultant but the report was stored as a document in the system.
- Tested HRD positive = HRD not recorded in system
- Tested BRCA positive (BRCAm) = 5 out of the 15
- 4. If data for HRD testing is available, please provide how many HRD positive patients were treated in the last 3 months with:

- Olaparib = HRD test not recorded
- Olaparib + Bevacizumab = HRD test not recorded
- Niraparib = HRD test not recorded
- Other treatments = HRD test not recorded
- 5. If data for HRD and BRCA testing is available, please provide how many HRD positive-BRCA positive patients were treated in the last 3 months with:
- Olaparib = HRD test not recorded
- Olaparib + Bevacizumab = HRD test not recorded
- Niraparib = HRD test not recorded
- Other treatments = HRD test not recorded
