Thank you for your email dated the 3/2/2022, requesting information in relation to hospital beds.

The information that you require is as follows: Stated separately for December 15, 2019, and December 15, 2021:

- 1) How many patient hospital beds did the trust have on its premises? This should be a total of all patient hospital beds, including those used as day beds and overnight beds.
- 2) How many patient hospital beds did the trust have open?
- 3) How many patient hospital beds did the trust have closed?
- 4) How many patient hospital beds were occupied by patients?
- 5) How many hospital wards and bays did the trust have?
- 6) How many hospital wards and bays had zero patients in them?

Our inpatient and daycase bed base moved in June 2020 when we opened our new hospital in Liverpool.

- In December 2019, these beds were located at Clatterbridge Cancer Centre Wirral.
- In December 2021, these beds were located at Clatterbridge Cancer Centre Liverpool.
