Thank you for your email dated the 22/06/2022, requesting information in relation to equipment life cycles.

The information you require is as follows:

I would like to know (segmented by hospital):

The process which the hospital follows for end-of-life equipment The Trust actively reviews equipment for end of shelf life which is stored in our H-IMS database managed by a 3rd party, data is extracted to an excel spreadsheet which is managed by our Medical Devices & Commodities Manager, recommendations are presented to the governing committee monthly. Requirements are presented to this committee in the form of a business case from the department Device owner) when revenue or capital support is considered.

The process by which the hospital decides that an equipment has reached its end of life. We have a 5 year equipment replacement plan and end-of-shelf life is determined with guidance from manufacturers based on their expected lifespan of the device or sooner if the device is no longer supported i.e. spares are no longer guaranteed.

Which companies the hospital works with in order to dispose of / sell off / repurpose... medical equipment

If the device is safe to use then we will consider selling using our PPM & Emergency Repair Contractor who engage in ethical re-sale with a pre-sale inspection. Anything condemned beyond economical repair or no longer fit for purpose is disposed of, following guidelines, through local contractors by our Estates Team.

The past data which the hospital has on where equipment has gone

Version: 1.0 Ref: ECGMFOIRE The Trust has had minimal disposal of equipment over the last 5 years, that which we have disposed of either goes to ethical resale through our contractor or to an auction house where there sale records are called upon for audit purposes.

All data is extracted from our minor electrical medical equipment database and uploaded to a excel spreadsheet which contains all the relevant data for review.

The data on which medical equipment the hospital currently has, when it was sourced and where it was sourced from, at what price

As with 5 above data is held on a H-IMS database and is referenced regularly to maintain our equipment managed under the direction of our Medical Devices & Commodities Manager, pricing records are the replacement cost rather than purchase price.
