Adenosine Triphosphate (ATP) Swab Results

Here at CCO the Infection Control team participate in environmental swabbing as part on the Infection control ward/departmental and on an ad hoc basis.

The table below provides an example of equipment that could be tested for audit purposes and a guide to the ATP scoring system.

Acceptable = Score demonstrates that surfaces are clean.

Caution = Cleaning methods should be evaluated and/or equipment material should be inspected to determine integrity and ensure that it be cleaned effectively.

Alert = Score demonstrates that cleaning methods **must** be assessed, investigated and evaluated. An action plan will be required, dependent upon findings.
