Thank you for your email, dated the 8th July 2019 requesting information regarding procurement.

The information that you require is as follows:

• What procurement system do you use?

Oracle Cloud

And is this also where you publish tenders?

No, the procurement function within The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre (CCC) is outsourced to Wirral University Teaching Hospital (WUTH) via a Service Level Agreement (SLA). We therefore utilise their e-tendering system.

- Do you publish tenders anywhere else, if so where?
 - a) For example, your website, Contracts Finder etc Yes, tenders are also published on Supplying2 NHS
- How much do you pay per annum for your procurement software?

Unfortunately it is not possible to split these costs from the overall financial system. The Trust purchase oracle financials with procurement as an element within this overall package.

• What are the contract start and end dates with the provider and when will the next tender become available?

As our procurement function is outsourced as part of an SLA with WUTH, the e-tendering system is owned and managed by our procurement services provider.
