Thank you for your email dated the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2019, requesting information regarding the application of NHS disciplinary procedures for doctors under the Maintaining High Professional Standards (MHPS) framework.

The information that you require is as follows:

## **Background**

I am conducting research on the application of NHS disciplinary procedures for doctors under the Maintaining High Professional Standards (MHPS) framework. The GMC produces annual reports of its statistics regarding complaints, investigations and their outcomes, but no such national data exists for the processes carried out within employer setups. I am therefore approaching each NHS employer in England to request statistics about concerns and investigations under MHPS.

Based on the NHS England National Report to Ministers on the Responsible Officer Regulations and Medical Revalidation 2017/18, more than 99% of NHS sector employers in England provide a report to their board detailing the number and type of concerns (under MHPS) and their outcome (see Figure 23 on page 46 in Section 3 of the linked report).

## The request

Please provide the following information about the disciplinary cases under MHPS in your organisation for the financial year 2017/18:

1. The number of permanent and locum doctors employed by the Trust (Headcount).

2. The number of concerns raised under MHPS by type of concern (the following is a suggested categorisation of the types of concern). Please allocate the cases to the most relevant type of concern.

Please note in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 our Trust is unable to release all of the information requested. The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre NHS Foundation Trust is a relatively small Trust and by providing this level of detail where the number of individuals is less than or equal to five increases any 'potential' risk of this data becoming identifiable information and thereby contravening one or more of the Data Protection Principles by releasing it into the public domain. Confidentiality is expected in such matters. This information is therefore exempt under Section 40: Personal Information, of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.The areas where this exemption has been applied are shown below:
